

Technician Training Course

What will be needed to do well in the Tech Training Course?

What will be needed to take an exam?

1. Technician exam

1. Federal Registration Number (FRN). Link below to register.

This number is now required on the 605 form which is submitted by the VEC testing coordinator for license applications.
2. Picture ID or two forms of identification, or if a legal guardian presents a photo ID only one form of identification is required.
3. Two number two pencils and a pen.
4. Fifteen dollars either in cash or check payable to Marple Newtown Amateur Radio Club.

2. License upgrade

1. Photocopy or a reference copy of your current Amateur Radio license. The copies will not be returned. [Obtain License Copy](#)
2. Two number two pencils and a pen.
3. Fifteen dollars either in cash or check payable to Marple Newtown Amateur Radio Club.

- A calculator with memory and formulas cleared may be used during the exam
- Cell phones must be turned off during the exam.
